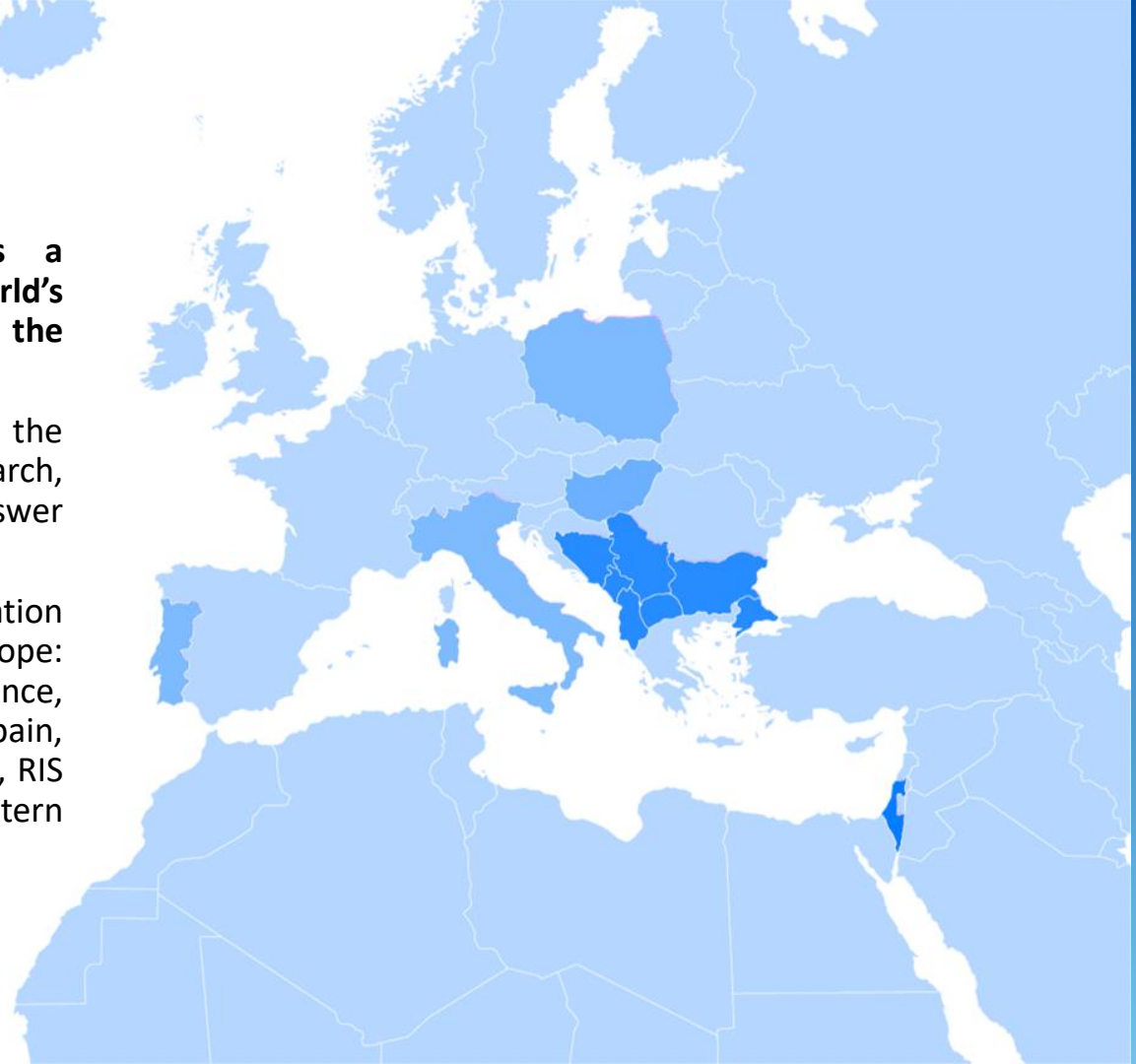

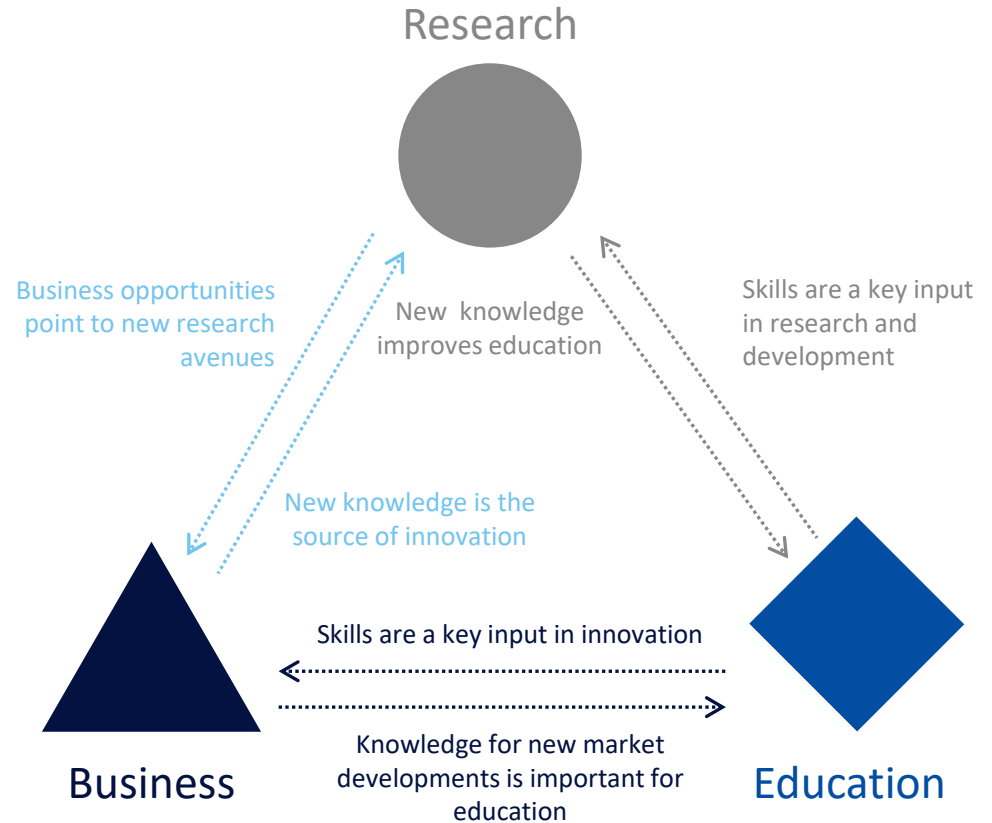


Our Approach

Education Programmes

i-Days

Oct – Nov 2023

- Challenge-based learning events
- They aim to inspire creativity and collaboration while encouraging a new generation of health innovators
- 1 or 2-day programmes in academic institutions hosted as individual local events at various cities across Europe between October and November
- All undergraduate and postgraduate students with an interest in healthcare innovation can participate
- Participants get introduction to practical health innovation tools, and compete in teams to tackle real-life health challenges
- Winning team of each i-Day attends the Winners' Event, a final competition uniting students from around Europe
- Up to now, i-Days have been organised in 47 cities, in 26 countries

Entrepreneurship 1-0-1 in Healthcare

- Online entrepreneurship course for individuals and teams, students, scientists, young entrepreneurs and innovators who have little or no experience in developing innovative solutions with commercial potential or setting up businesses, and therefore need practical knowledge on how to bring their ideas to the market
- 4 weeks long (approx. 4-5 hours/week)
- 4 modules on how to set up a startup, product-market fit, problem-solution fit, business models
- Video lectures, suggested readings, case studies, interviews, quizzes for knowledge check, certificate upon successful completion
- Video lectures are presented by successful startup owners, mentors and coaches

- Capacitate the participants with tools and methodologies for future development of entrepreneurial ventures, social enterprises, and intrapreneurial projects that have an impact on healthcare systems and patients' lives

- Experts and mentors will help you understand and refine your project, business and financial plan.

- Participants take a closer look at the market and their competition, receiving help needed to better understand medical device regulations and how these apply to their projects.

Patient Innovation Bootcamp

Online + Onsite (June 27 – Nov 3, 2023)

- Supports the development and launch of innovative solutions created by people directly affected by health conditions, such as patients and informal caregivers.
- The aim is to help them move their solutions from ideas to prototypes to market-ready innovations.
- Supports innovations at the development stage or beyond that have a proof of concept or feasibility.
- Consists of mentoring and training in Lisbon, medical and technology validation in Barcelona, implementation and dissemination in Copenhagen, and online training regarding business model design in between.

Online + Onsite (July – November, 2023)

- Acceleration program for early-stage startups from Central, Eastern, and Southern Europe.
- Helps transform prototypes and MVPs into health solutions or products and bring them to market.
- Place for investors looking for gems in biotech, medtech, and life sciences.
- Win up to 25 000 € to launch your product or service, to find first customers and to get in connection with EIT Health Partners from all over Europe.

EIT Jumpstarter

Online + Onsite (June - December, 2023)

- Pre-accelerator run by 7 EIT KICs, including Health
- Aims to push early-stage innovators from emerging European regions onto the market and help their scientific ideas and innovations become successful businesses.
- Selected teams work with expert trainers and mentors and deep dive together into business modelling and business planning.
- The six best teams in each category are qualified for the Grand Final, where they compete for the prize of 10,000 EUR in each category.
- Apply by April 16!

Opportunities for more mature startups

- **User Validation Labs**: Connects startups with living labs, accelerators, hospitals and innovation centres in the EIT Health network, where you can test your product or service with patients, clinicians, and medical staff.
- **Bridgehead**: For startups registered in Europe, who want to grow their business in the European market.
- **Catapult**: For startups looking for seed or series A funding, showcasing them to leading experts and investors across Europe.
- **Gold Track**: Pairing promising companies with top life science advisors who help to set them on a path to success, and massively scale them within a short timeframe.
- **Venture Center of Excellence**: Co-investment programme of EIT Health and EIF for SMEs with TRL6+, who seek more than 6 million EUR in their next fundraising round.
- **Wild Card**: For startups addressing an unmet need for children's health, with a product at TRL 3-6, with a team of 2-5 founders.
